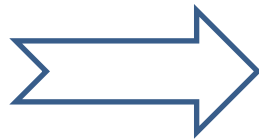
- Two symposia accepted

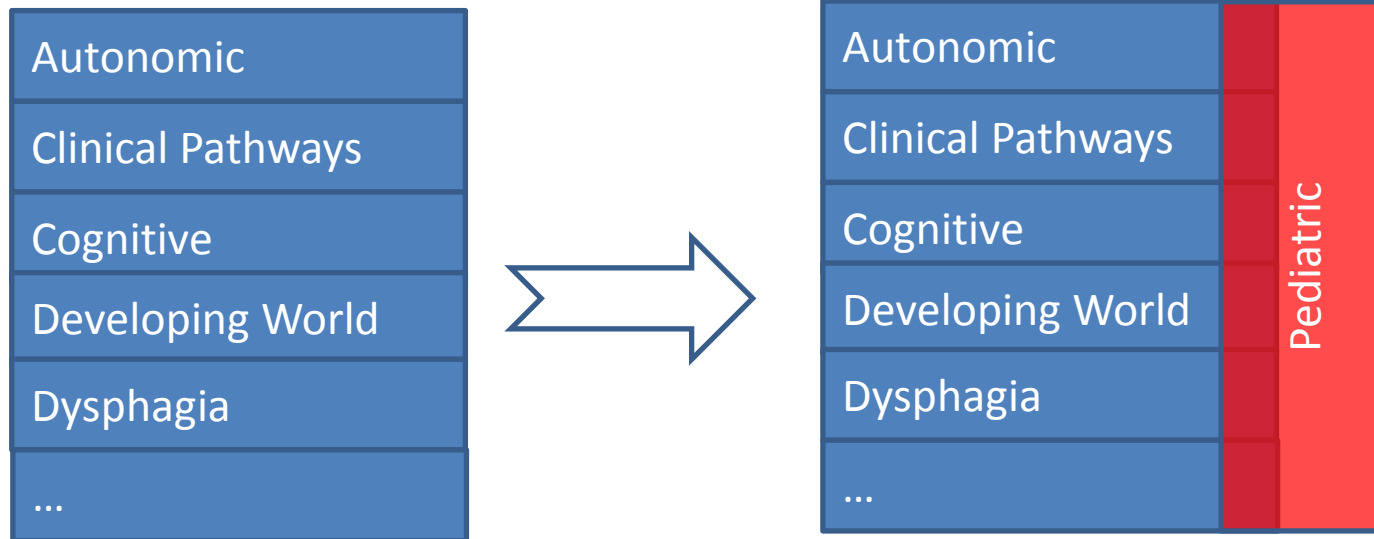
